COVID-19 EVENT GUIDELINES

The Charlotte Dog Training Club (CDTC) will be implementing the following protocols during this trial.

These guidelines are designed with the safety of event participants, volunteers, and judges in mind. These guidelines are being publicized in advance to allow exhibitors to make decisions as to whether to participate. If you feel that either 1) your safety is at risk, or 2) you cannot comply with these guidelines, please do not enter this event.

1. Face Coverings:

- All exhibitors, judges and volunteers must wear face coverings while inside the building, except to eat or drink. Masks should be either a cloth or surgical or N95 type; they should be well-fitting, cover the nose and mouth, and not require the use of hands to hold in place. We will be operating in accordance with whatever the [NC Executive Order](#) is at the time of the event with regards to face coverings.
- For additional information, see the [CDC guidance on Masks](#).
- Should you forget, masks can be purchased on site.

2. Restrooms and Hygiene:

- **Avoid physical contact with others, shared surfaces, objects, or dogs other than your own. This applies inside as well as outside the building.**
- Our indoor bathrooms will be available for use at your own risk. Please clean yourself in and out. Sanitizing wipes, paper towels, and other cleaners will be readily available. It's up to each individual to use these cleaning supplies as they see fit before you use the facilities rather than assume the person before you did as they left. CDTC will be monitoring the restrooms regularly to ensure supplies are well stocked. Thank you for helping us keep the restrooms tidy and clean. Please alert us if you see something that needs attention.
- Frequent hand washing is strongly encouraged.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for use.

3. Social distancing:

All participants will be expected to maintain at least 6' of social distancing at all times while on the property (the more the better) unless you're members of the same household.

4. Parking:

Please park in designated areas. Maintain at least 2 parking spaces between each vehicle. We have plenty of space to spread out so feel free to bring your popup tents, x-pens etc. for use outside, near your car. Flexi leads are not allowed within 50 ft. of the building but can be used further out.

Be considerate of your neighbor and don't leave your car running while you are parked. If you need to run your engine for more than a few minutes please drive away from the main parking area to do so.

5. Check in :

- An outdoor check in station will enable exhibitors to check themselves in at each door. Each exhibitor will be provided with a packet that will include armbands & rubber bands, a number sign for your vehicle, a facility map, the judging schedule, and instructions. You'll place the vehicle ID sign somewhere prominent on or inside your vehicle so we can find you if need be. Picking up this packet will check you in for all classes over the weekend. **If you will be absent from any classes that you're registered for, please let the Secretary know as soon as possible.**

6. Time in the building

- Exhibitors will stage outside the designated entry door based on the ring # for your class. Each ring has its own designated warm up area inside the building. As one team finishes and exits, another will be called to enter.
- Exhibitors will be expected to leave the building after judging.

7. Rally Walk Through: Walk-throughs may take place in smaller groups (# tbd) to maintain social distancing.

8. Crating and chairs:

- There will be no indoor crating or chairs for exhibitors.
- Exhibitors will crate from their vehicle. You will display a dog ID sign (provided) prominently on your vehicle wherever it can be most easily seen by volunteers if we need to find you.

9. Spectators: Depending on what state/county regulations are at the time, exhibitors *may* be allowed to have 1 person accompany them to video. Otherwise, there will be no spectators in the building.

10. Food and Drinks: No food or drinks will be available on site during the trials for exhibitors. There are a variety of restaurants and grocery stores nearby.

11. Awards: Placement, New Title, and Specialty ribbons will not be awarded in the ring. These will be placed on a self-service awards table. Qualifying ribbons will be available at exit doors for exhibitors to pick up after their run if they want one. Exhibitors will be responsible for collecting their own ribbons.

I understand that if I am not in compliance with these guidelines, and I refuse to comply, I will be asked to leave the trial and entry fees will be forfeited.

I agree that I am attending this Charlotte Dog Training Club event entirely at my own risk and assume all risk and full responsibility for my own health, wellbeing, and safety during this event. I fully agree that Charlotte Dog Training Club is in no way liable for any present or future COVID-19 exposure incurred at any time by any person, in attendance or not in attendance, during or after this event, and I hereby waive, release and hold harmless the Charlotte Dog Training Club including its members, judges and volunteers required to host the competition, and its Board of Directors from any claim, and from any and all liability for damages thereto.

I understand the COVID 19 virus situation is continually changing which means that these guidelines may be adjusted as needed.

RULES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE and any updates will be communicated via our website, our FB page for this event, and through our Secretary using the email you provide when you register.

I understand that a valid entry **REQUIRES** my signature verifying my agreement with this document.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITOR

The American Kennel Club (AKC) Rules and Regulations will govern this Trial and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the AKC referred to on the reverse side of the entry form in this Premium List

ENTRIES

No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. **Signature required, unsigned entries, and entries received without payment will not be accepted. Note: Entry Forms without the full AKC Agreement and Rules and signature on the reverse side will not be accepted.**

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The club will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Entries will be acknowledged via email as they are received and processed. PLEASE VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF YOUR ENTRY INFORMATION as soon as you receive the processing email.

Confirmation and armband number will be sent via email after entries close. Those without an email address will be mailed by USPS to the address on the entry form. Please be sure to add **ShowEntries.Info** to your email allowed list.

REFUNDS

Refunds (less the administrative processing fee) will be made for bitches in season if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly.

If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the club it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made.

LOSS OR DAMAGE

The Trial Committee and the trial secretary will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Trials.

SHOW SITE

TRIAL HOURS are from 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M.

The show building will not be available to exhibitors on Friday prior to the trial.

NO SMOKING ALLOWED IN THE SHOW BUILDING

NO FIREARMS ALLOWED IN THE SHOW BUILDING OR SHOW GROUNDS

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. Dogs must be ready for judging. Exhibitors alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring. Judges are not required to wait for any dog holding up a class.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From Greenville, SC:

Take I-85 North to South I-485 (exit 30) towards Pineville.

Take I-77/21 South (exit 67) towards Columbia.

Note: on I-485 the exit numbers will decline to 0 then start at 67 at the I-77 exit.

On I-77 South, take exit 90 (Rt. 21 Carowinds Blvd).

Turn right onto Carowinds Blvd and go 0.8 mile to Choate Circle (3rd stoplight). Turn left onto Choate Circle and go 1.7 miles to the show site on the right.

From Virginia/Raleigh:

Take I-85 South to I-77 South to Carowinds Blvd. Exit.

Then follow the Greenville directions

From Columbia SC:

Take I-77 North to Carowinds Blvd Exit.

Turn left and follow the Greenville directions

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience & Rally trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.
